We will also learn about the ancient dreaming practices of Mexico and the power of the nahual, or dream body. Please bring a journal and a dream you would like to work with to the session.

A personal story of integrating spirituality into the practice of limpia's, platicas and soul retrievals. The workshop also includes the use of drum medicine, reiki, and the teachings of the abuelas in walking the path to healing themselves and others.

The Different Healing Cleanses From The Indigenous Mayan Perspective

Mayan cleansings have been approached from many perspectives, in reality indigenous peoples have their own vision about their use, and implementing the tools and instruments that they have at hand, specially when an emergency emerges. The indigenous healer has the ability to analyze, observe and initiate treatment according to the situation followed by a treatment program according to the person's needs.

Illnesses and Treatments Recognized Within the Mayan Indigenous Medicines.

There are several psychosomatic diseases recognized and treated in the Mayan indigenous medicine that are not recognized or treated in western medicine. These are sometimes classified as viral or bacterial, which in reality in ancestral medicine they are not. For example, the temperature of internal organs. This workshop will guide you to demystify and help the individual to go deeper into healing the root cause of illnesses that have been misdiagnosed by conventional medicine.
